The company will leverage Sumitomo's knowledge and experience in affiliate marketing and digital advertising to expand its business by developing go-to-market collaborations to serve Japanese advertisers or partner with Japanese agencies.



SoftBank Corp., a Fortune 500 telecommunications company, has invested \$60 million in ADA, the largest independent analytics, data, and AI digital marketing business in South and Southeast Asia. The investment will be used to enhance ADA's data and AI offerings, as well as its marketing solutions to brands and enterprises. SoftBank will also form a business alliance with ADA to make it the core of its digital and data marketing arm in Southeast Asia, leveraging its network of portfolio companies to create synergy globally.

Post-investment, SoftBank will own a 23.07% shareholding of ADA, establishing ADA's valuation at \$260 million.

Another best moment of my life was doing the bungee jump in Nepal, which is the second highest bungee jump in the world.




